Professionals in this industry require a deep understanding of regulations and compliance orders. Despite the shrinking growth rate of compliance officers in Orange County, various other related occupation are expected to outpace both state and national growth rates.

Coordinate, prepare, or review regulatory submissions for domestic or international projects.

Provide technical review of data or reports that will be incorporated into regulatory submissions to assure scientific rigor, accuracy, and clarity of presentation.

Review product promotional materials, labeling, batch records, specification sheets or test methods for compliance with applicable regulations.

Maintain current knowledge base of existing and emerging regulations, standards, or guidance documents.

Interpret regulatory rules and ensure that they are communicated through corporate policies and procedures.




