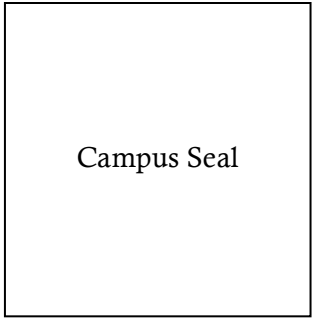

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR SB 1914* CROSS ENROLLMENT

California Community Colleges - California State University – University of California

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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Any student enrolled in any campus of the California Community Colleges, the California State University, or the University of California may enroll without formal admission in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either of the other systems. Enrollment is on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities. Enrollment is excluded in the following areas: Remedial, Graduate (Including Teacher Education courses at the 200 and 300 level).

A student is eligible to participate in the Cross Enrollment Program if they meet all of the following requirements:

- Completed at least one term as a matriculated student at the home institution.
- Enrolled in a minimum of 6 units at the home institution during same term of program participation.
- Earned a cumulative GPA of 2.0 (grade of C) for all work completed at the home institution.
- Paid appropriate tuition and fees at the home institution for the term of participation.
- Has not been academically disqualified from either institution.
- Resident of California.

ENROLLMENT CONDITIONS: Prior to enrollment, student must secure approval of home campus college/school for Cross Enrollment to ensure course meets home campus requirements.

1. Approval for cross-enrollment is valid **only for the one term specified** and subject to space availability, deadlines, registration procedures and priorities at UCI.
2. The cost to enroll is \$46.00 per unit, \$10.00 computer account fee, and any additional fees required by UCI departments (lab, materials, departmental, breakage, computer, transcript, etc.) will be assessed. Please note enrollment in UCI courses during Summer Session will be assessed an additional Visitor campus fee. Please visit the UCI Summer Session website for fee information (<https://summer.uci.edu/services/registration/fees.aspx>).
3. Academic advisement is available only at the home campus.
4. Students are urged to secure approval of the home campus Registrar first to ensure course meets home campus requirements.
5. Evidence of completion of course prerequisites (e.g., an official transcript) may be required at time of enrollment by the instructor/academic counselor.
6. Financial aid is available only through home campus. Students eligible for Veterans, Rehabilitation, Social Security and other Federal, State or County benefits must secure eligibility certification through home campus.
7. Students are subject to all UC Irvine Division of Continuing Education *Concurrent Enrollment* administrative procedures and deadlines (<https://ce.uci.edu/courses/concurrent/>). Note: Students must process official drop at UC Irvine Division of Continuing Education Student Services or risk having an unsatisfactory grade recorded on permanent record.
8. Permanent academic records are maintained at the Student Services Office at the UC Irvine Division of Continuing Education. Official transcripts - <https://ce.uci.edu/resources/academic/transcripts/>.
9. Health Services on host campus are limited to treatment for emergencies.
10. Because of overlapping academic calendars, cross enrollment is possible only in certain combinations.
